Background: This agenda item affords the General Manager the opportunity to update the Board members and public on current and future projects, activities and other items related to the Corporation's business.

- The City has issued a permit to build a new house at 133 Timber Ridge.
- The city has issued a permit to build a residential addition at 7002 N. Travis.
- The city has issued a permit for a residential remodel at 202 Chesson.
- On November 14, the City Council approved the purchase of a new fire truck. LCDC provided half of the funds for the fire truck. The estimated delivery date for the fire truck is April or May of 2025.
- The old Library sign was removed on November 15. The new sign was installed on December 1.
- The Golf Course range mats were delivered on November 16. Installation is expected to take place on December 14.
- The gas carts at the golf course were picked up on December 12.
- The wildlife fencing project at the Airport is currently undergoing surveying and design. Preliminary designs were completed on November 20. Final Design is expected by January 1st. Construction is expected to start on June 1, 2024 and be completed by October 1, 2024.
- Wendy's broke ground on their new store at 1912 US 90 on November 27.

- The new LED runway lights for the airport are expected to be delivered the week of December 18.
- The City has signed a contract with Clayton Bracey for the Highway 90 Tree Replacement Project. The TxDOT Area Office has given tentative approval for the project.
- Faux Real Trade Days is on December 15 – 17. All activities take place at the TVE Fairgrounds (321 FM 563).

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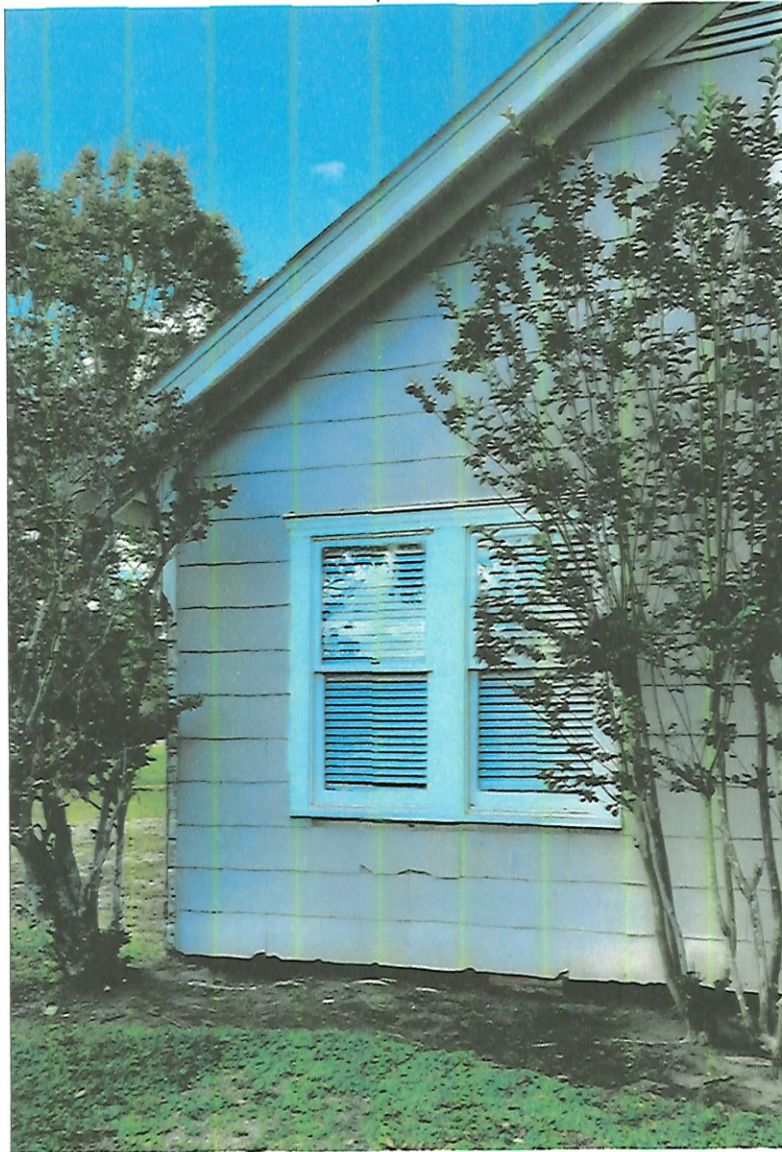

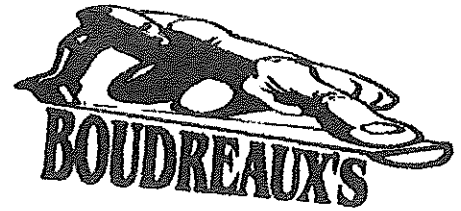
